The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.33 dated 02.04.2021 under Sections 363/366-A IPC (Section 376 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act added lateron) registered at Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, havev joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant submits that

the petitioners herein have played an active role.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and that the matter has been investigated.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

In view of the facts that the petitioners herein are the parents of Ajay Kachura who had approach this Court along with the daughter of the complainant seeking protection which was allowed, the matter has been investigated and petitioners have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 24.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
