1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court, to move a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the petition for regular bail, in a time bound manner.
3. The same is not opposed to by the learned State counsel nor the learned counsel for the complainant.
4. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of the petitioner moving a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible by taking into account all aspects of the matter, including the conditions prevailing on account of Corona Virus pandemic.
