Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0170 dated 02.09.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Section 326 IPC added subsequently and Section 307 IPC added later on but now deleted and then again added while framing charges, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 21.05.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 21.05.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery has also been effected from him.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Lekha Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not

required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.05.2021 granting *ad-interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
