The present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of respondents No.2 and 3 in not issuing the admit card/roll number to the petitioner requiring for appearing in the IV Semester Examination (Social Work) being conducted through online mode as a candidate of improvement category.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State has referred to para 3 of the reply, which reads as under:-

“This it is brought to the notice of this Hon'ble Court that in reference to the application of petitioner-Mr. Rahul, VPO-Salvan, Tehsil, Assandh, District Karnal regarding the conduct of improvement examination of Master of Social Work-4th Semester of May, 2021, the University has decided to conduct these examinations. Therefore, the Roll No. of petitioner Mr. Rahul has been uploaded on KUK website. Any pending paper of the said examination will be conducted later during current schedule of examination itself. Moreover, as and when the

examinations of Master of Social Work-2nd Semester taken place, the petitioner will be issued Roll No. and Admit Card and allowed to appear for the improvement examinations of said 2nd semester also.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Ordered accordingly.
