Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 25.01.2021 under Sections 120-B and 420 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 23.08.2021, demand draft amounting to Rs.5 lakhs favouring complainant- Bhupinder Singh Toor has already been deposited in the Court concerned on 06.09.2021 and further petitioner has no objection if the demand draft of Rs.5 lakhs is released in favour of complainant- Bhupinder Singh Toor. Ordered accordingly.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Mohan Lal, submits that in compliance of order dated 23.08.2021, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 23.08.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
