1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating order (Annexure P-1) dated 03.02.2020 passed by this Court in CWP No.7014 of 2017 in case titled as 'Hari Ram versus State of Haryana and others'.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.440 of 2021 has stayed the operation of order (Annexure P-1) dated 03.02.2020 in CWP No.7014 of 2017, therefore, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such by granting liberty to the petitioner to move

an application for revival of the contempt petition in the eventuality of

interim order being vacated or the LPA being decided in favour of the petitioner.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
