Present application has been filed for placing on record the relevant documents necessary for the adjudication of the present petition.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and documents are permitted to be taken on record.

CWP-10040-2021

In the present writ petition, the petitioners are claiming appointments as Block Resource Coordinators-cum- Community Facilitator on the ground that the petitioners have already cleared all the required parameters for such appointment.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the appointments of the petitioners are being withheld on the ground that the qualification which they have obtained from Eastern Institute for Integrated Learning In Management, Sikkim is disputed. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that after the filing of the petition, this Court has laid down law in somewhat similar case and therefore, the petitioners will be satisfied, at this

stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents-State to decide the claim of the petitioners keeping in view the settled principle of law in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even they are ready to file a fresh representation giving the complete facts and law for the consideration of the authorities for passing an appropriate speaking order on the claim of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State very fairly submits that in case, the petitioners approach the authorities by filing any representation by giving details of the facts as well as law, the same will be considered by the authorities in accordance with law and appropriate order on the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of six weeks from the receipt of any such representation.

This satisfy the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, at this stage with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents raising their claim as raised in the present writ petition by filing appropriate representation and in case, any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same be disposed of within a period of six weeks by the competent authority by passing an appropriate speaking order as undertaken by the State counsel.

It is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioners, at this stage.

As the main case is disposed of, application i.e. CM-6987-CWP-2021 is also disposed of.
