Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 10.04.2021 under Sections 379, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 25.05.2021: -

“Inter alia contends that the FIR in question, arises out of what is essentially a civil dispute between the two sisters owing to their differences on the inheritance of the property of deceased father. He submits that on the basis of concocted allegations, the

petitioner No.1, who is son of one of the sisters, has been falsely implicated in the FIR...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that primary dispute is regarding possession of the property between sisters.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.05.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
