The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 98 dated 07.04.2021 under Sections 34, 323, 354, 406, 498-A and 506 IPC (Sections 34, 323, 354 and 506 IPC has been deleted) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Rohtak, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that pursuant to order dated 24.05.2021 petitioner has joined the investigation. He would further submit that a petition for quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise is also filed before this Court vide CRM-M-25574-2021 which is listed on 06.09.2021.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions from SI Sakshi submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation and a petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise having already been filed, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 24.05.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
