Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.119 dated 25.09.2020 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 25.05.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that since the allegations against the petitioner are of taking money from the complainant for sending him abroad, on behalf of his son Puran Deep Singh, the petitioner is still ready to explore the possibility of some settlement and to show his bonafide, he will

deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- with the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of one month from today, without prejudice to his right of defence...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of the order dated 07.06.2021 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rajpura and submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he has also furnished FDR of Rs.50,000/-.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harnek Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.05.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
