When this Court is about to dictate the order, after hearing the arguments addressed by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel at length in the instant petition, learned counsel for the petitioner, on realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant the relief of bail, as prayed for in this petition, specially in the eventuality when the rigor of Section 37 of the NDPS Act would be applicable in view of the fact that the quantity of the contraband (poppy husk), as allegedly recovered in this case, falls within the category of “commercial quantity”, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Accordingly, the same stands dismissed as having been withdrawn.
