The petitioner was an applicant for the post of Lambardar. The Deputy Commissioner, however, appointed respondent No.3 in the first instance, which was challenged by the petitioner before the learned Commissioner. The learned Commissioner set aside the order of the Deputy Commissioner and remanded the case. The order of the learned Commissioner is under challenge in revision petition before learned Financial Commissioner, Revenue, who has stayed operation of order of the learned Commissioner.

It is submitted that meanwhile, respondent No.3 continues to act as Lambardar, which is illegal. A complaint dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) has been made regarding the same to respondent No.2 but he has failed to take any action thereupon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

Ms. Lavanya Paul, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 & 2 and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to file reply.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
