The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 and 4 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act 1988, read with Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 read with Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Rules, 2007 directing the respondents to grant the parole to the petitioner on the demise of his mother namely Smt. Surjit Kaur on 10.05.2021 and the ritual ceremony is now fixed for today, i.e. 21.05.2021 in village Milk Khas, District Yamuna Nagar.

When the case was initially taken up for hearing, counsel for the State was called upon to verify the factual aspect with regard to the demise of Smt.Surjit Kaur wife of Satpal, mother of the petitioner. Counsel for the State has forwarded a report which has been received by her which is

taken on record. As per the said report, the factual assertion with regard to the sad demise of Smt.Surjit Kaur stands accepted.

In the light of above factual assertion and keeping in view the aspect that the last ritual ceremony of mother of the petitioner is scheduled for today, i.e. 21.05.2021, the petitioner is directed to be released by the respondents forthwith on parole for a period of 4 days. He shall surrender before the jail authorities on 25.05.2021 at 10.00 AM.

The petition stands disposed of.
