Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54, dated 16.04.2021, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

Complainant in the present case is Allahabad Bank.

Allegations are that a loan facility had been taken by the petitioner along with co-accused i.e. his wife against a certain property. In spite of the property in question having been mortgaged and the loan amount being outstanding, petitioner along with co-accused i.e. his wife had already sold the property.

Conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles him from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Being confronted with the situation where this Court was

inclined to dismiss the petition, counsel seeks withdrawal of the petition.
