The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is being harassed by respondents No.6 and 7. Respondent No.7 is a Head Constable in Punjab Police and respondent No.6 is his father. There were money dealings between brother of the petitioner and respondent No.6. Brother of the petitioner was taken away by the police without disclosing any reason. Petitioner was also taken away by the police on 13.03.2021 and in CIA Staff, Bathinda, he came to know that his brother was kept in illegal custody for the last 03 days. Petitioner and his brother filed anticipatory bail wherein petitioner and his brother

were directed to join the investigation as some complaint was pending against them. Qua son of the petitioner, petition for anticipatory bail was rendered infructuous vide order dated 19.03.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite joining the investigation by the police, petitioner is being harassed and is being compelled to return the money to respondent No.6 who is doing a construction business.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents, as no order prejudicial to the interest of any party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the representation of the petitioner dated 11.05.2021 in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
