By this petition, the petitioners have challenged the amalgamation of four villages in the Municipal Committee, Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection, the petitioners have moved representations Annexures P-5 and P-6 and that the petitioners would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the same by passing a speaking order. The election is now fixed for 31.5.2021.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Suveer Sheokand, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice and states that actually the points raised in the petition are covered against the petitioner by the decision of Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-11619-2020 titled as Kulwinder Singh vs. Union of India and others, decided on 25.1.2021. He further states that even though there is no provision in the Rules for the representation, yet the respondents would have no objection in deciding the representations of the petitioners.

We find it a fair stand. In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representations Annexure P-5 and P-6 by passing a speaking order thereon on or before 28.5.2021.
