The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to allot seats for B-1 course in 35% category in Haryana Armed Police Force (HAP) Battalions in the State of Haryana strictly as per the provisions contained under Rule 13.7 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 as applicable to the State of Haryana and fixing their seniority accordingly and further directing the respondents

to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 03.02.2020
