The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to the respondents not to interfere in the lawful and legitimate possession of the petitioners over the property in question.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that legal notice (Annexure P-1) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that respondents will look into the matter and will decide the legal notice of the petitioners. Counsel for the

petitioners is directed to send a complete copy of the paper book on whatsapp number of the counsel appearing for the State during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
