After arguing for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to grant any relief, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition, since the petitioner intends to surrender before Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar and move an application for regular bail.

He has however requested that keeping in view the young age of the petitioner, i.e. 18 years, not having any past criminal record and prevailing pandemic situation, the application for regular bail be ordered to be decided expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is observed that on petitioner surrendering before Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar within 7 days from today and moving an application for regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.
