The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.386 dated 07.10.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is argued that no offence is made out against the petitioner. It is also contended that the petitioner is not the beneficiary of the Will. It is also submitted that the petitioner is suffering from cancer.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, AAG Haryana, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondent-State and opposes the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. She submits that the present petitioner herein along with his father forged the Will in question and on the basis of said forged Will, the property was transferred in the name of the petitioner and he subsequently transferred the said property in the name of his father. Thus, the petitioner herein has played an important role in the whole conspiracy.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner herein seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, with the prayer that the petitioner will surrender before the trial court, however, his application for grant of regular bail be considered expeditiously.

Request is acceded to.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, in case, the petitioner herein surrenders before the trial court/Illaq Magistrate within a week and moves his application for grant of regular bail, the said application be considered and decided by the trial court/Illaq Magistrate and will consider his medical condition, if any, within a week thereafter.
