This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 166 dated 1.9.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 459, 506 IPC at Police Station Jhojhu Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

FIR was registered on the complaint of one Ajay who stated that on the night of 15.8.2020, he alongwith his wife and son aged about 2 years was sleeping in upper portion of his house. Their driver Rakesh was sleeping in baithak. At about 2:00 am, complainant saw from window 2 persons were roaming in the verandah of his house. They entered the house and caused injury on his head with heavy object. When complainant tried to raise voice, then they shut his mouth by putting hand. They threw complainant from roof. On hearing noise, their driver Rakesh woke up. He also was caused injuries by assailants. Out of 7/8 assailants, they identified accused Khunda and Rinku.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner has not been named in FIR. It is only in the supplementary statement of complainant recorded a month thereafter that petitioner has been named. The investigation in the case is complete and challan has already been filed. Petitioner is in custody since 10.12.2020.

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Without commenting anything on merit of case and also bearing in mind the investigation in the case is complete and the petitioner is in custody since 10.12.2020, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
