The petitioner, by filing a civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, assails the correctness of the order dated 04.03.2021, through which her services as contractual employee have been dispensed with. It is not in dispute that the petitioner was engaged on temporary basis as an Assistant for a period of six months through office order dated 03.12.2018 and thereafter, her tenure was extended from time to time. Her services have been dispensed with on 04.03.2021 as the term of the contractual appointment has come to an end.

Mr. Tribhuvan Dahiya, Advocate, while entering appearance on behalf of respondent no. 1 to 3 has informed the bench that the post of Assistant is meant to filled up by promotion and the process of making regular promotion has already been initiated,

however, due to COVID-19 pandemic, it is taking some time. He further submits that the University does not intend to fill up the post by engaging any other contractual employee.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to issue the writ petition as prayed for, is made out. Hence, dismissed. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail alternative remedy, if any available.
