The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* to raid the premises of respondents No.4 to 11 and to recover detainee, Rajwant Kaur, daughter of the petitioner, from their alleged illegal confinement.

Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court towards the statement got recorded by detainee, Rajwant Kaur, which is attached with the additional affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Valtoha, as Annexure R-1/T. In her statement, she stated that she had performed marriage with respondent No.4-Akashdeep Singh @ Manga on 05.10.2020 and she is now residing in his house at village Dubli.

Keeping in view the statement suffered by the alleged detainee, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present criminal writ petition.

Dismissed being not pressed.
