The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioners are aged persons. They have prayed for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting their lives and personal liberties from being invaded by respondents No.4 and 5. Husband of petitioner No.1 has already died on 09.04.2020. Petitioner is a divorcee in view of divorce dated 20.11.2008 passed by the Court at Canada.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have solemnized the marriage on 15.05.2021 as per Anand Karaj. Now they face constant threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Petitioners have also moved a representation to respondent No.2 on 19.05.2021 through registered post, but the same has not been acted upon so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, without meaning anything in the context of validity and legality of marriage of the petitioners, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners and pass an appropriate order on merits in accordance with law. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved in any other case. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
