This second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for pre-arrest bail has been filed by the petitioner Balwinder Singh, aged about 55 years, resident of village Jalalabad, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur, an accused in FIR No.259 dated 26.12.2020, under Sections 353, 186, 506 IPC, registered with Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur. The first petition bearing CRM-M-3621-2021 filed by petitioner had been dismissed vide detailed order dated 27.1.2021 passed by this Court.

Hon'ble Apex Court in a recent judgment **G.R. Ananda**

Babu Versus The State of Tamil Nadu & Anr. arising out of SLP(Crl.)

No.213 of 2021 has observed that the specious reason of change in circumstances cannot be invoked for successive anticipatory bail applications, once it is rejected by a speaking order and that too by the same Judge.

Therefore, the present petition is not maintainable and stands dismissed accordingly.
