Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the entire daily-wage service of the petitioners as Special Police Officers (SPOs) rendered prior to their regularization/ enlistment as Constables as qualifying service for the purposes of pensionary/ service benefits.

Instead of pressing the petition on merits, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that his clients would be satisfied in case, representation dated 18.12.2020 (P-6) is decided by the competent authority expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Additional AG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this petition

is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 18.12.2020 (P-6) of the petitioners within a period of 8 (eight) weeks from today by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
