This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to official respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents as well as the local police, especially respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has retired from CISF. Grievance of the petitioner is that after retirement, when he returned to his native village Lower Majari, Tehsil Nangal, District Roopnagar, he was harassed by the private respondents and was not allowed to cultivate his land. Copy of the jamabandi in respect of the land of petitioner is attached as Annexure P-1 (Colly.). With regard to his grievance, petitioner has made an application dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar, seeking protection against the private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar-respondent No.2 to look into the application/representation dated 17.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) and take action in accordance with law.
