Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.80 dated 10.04.2019 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 21.06.2021, the petitioner has already prepared a bank draft of Rs.2.00 lacs, to be deposited in SBI, Rajpura, loan account of petitioner Rajvir Singh and the same will be handed over to the complainant-bank within a period of three days from today. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 05 months and 11 days; offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate

and it will take some time in conclusion of the trial and the petitioner is ready to explore the possibility of settlement.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 15.07.2021 in the Court today and however submitted that the FIR was registered at the instance of Chief Manager, SBI with the allegations that the petitioner has impersonated himself as his father Amarjit Singh and got the sale deed executed regarding the land, on which loan was already obtained, therefore, he has committed the serious offence.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner has volunteered to deposit Rs.2.00 lacs in his loan account of SBI, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned and on showing a receipt to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate regarding deposit of aforesaid bank draft with the complainant-bank.

Petition is disposed of.
