The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioners seek issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect lives and personal liberties of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners by referring to transactions leading to sale and purchase of the land submits that the case is of civil profile for which no legal remedy has been availed by respondent No.5 but respondent No.5 by using his clout seeks to recover the earnest money from the petitioner with the help of respondent No.4 who is hell bent to implicate the petitioner in some false case if earnest money is not

returned to respondent No.5

Precisely for the grievance of the petitioners, they have filed representations to respondents No.4 and 2 on 09.04.2021 and 16.04.2021 respectively.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents, as no order prejudicial to the interest of any party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 16.04.2021 of the petitioners in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
