The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.59 dated 08.04.2021 registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala, under Sections 323/325/506 read with Section 34 IPC.

Status-reports filed on behalf of the respondent-State by way of the affidavits of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Naraingarh, District Ambala dated 15.07.2021 and dated 16.09.2021, along-with Annexures R-1 and R-2, are already available on the file and these documents are taken on the record.

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of the order dated 26.05.2021, as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and he points out that as specifically deposed in para 7 of the preliminary submissions in the status-report/affidavit dated 15.07.2021, the petitioner got the weapon of offence(Axe/Kulhari)

recovered in pursuance of his disclosure statement and on the instructions from HC Narain Singh of Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala, he further apprises the Court that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the above-discussed submissions of learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the interim relief, as extended by the Co-ordinate Bench to the petitioner vide the said order dated 26.05.2021, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
