On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet S. Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioner No.1 has placed on record copy of Voter Card

(Annexure P-1) and petitioner No.2 has placed on record the copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) as proof of their age. Copy of photographs (Annexure P-3 and P-4) and Marriage Certificate (Annexure P-5) have also been placed on record.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - S.H.O., Police Station Pitara, District Jalandhar, that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
