The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in his third attempt under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0053 dated 13.05.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 325, 326, 307, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC Act 1860 and later on added Sections 181 and 192 of Motor Vehicle Act 1988 registered at P.S. Maharban, District Ludhiana.

CRM-M No.3354 of 2020 was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 24.08.2020. Thereafter, CRM-M No.40692 of 2020 was also dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated

12.01.2021.

As per prosecution story when the complainant was coming back from his personal work from village Garhi Sheru on his motorcycle, then at about 10:00 AM one tractor make Sawraj came from the side of Garhi Sheru driven by the petitioner in a very rash and negligent manner. Kamal was sitting with the petitioner on the said tractor. Petitioner raised lalkara that the complainant be not spared and struck his tractor against the motorcycle of the complainant. The complainant fell down on the ground along with his motorcycle. The petitioner brought his tractor and ran him over by dragging him and his motorcycle in the fields. One popular tree was also damaged in this act of the petitioner. Kamal also exhorted to bring the tractor back again and to finish the complainant. Petitioner again brought the tractor and ran the same over the body of the complainant. Believing that the complainant was dead, they left the spot.

The only grievance of the petitioner is that the trial has not made any progress despite his custody of two years.

Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no indulgence can be granted in favour of the petitioner that too in his third repeated attempt.

Petition stands dismissed at this stage.
