This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No. 10, dated 18.03.2021 under Sections 420/120-B IPC and Sections 7, 7-
A of P.C.Act registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala.

This Court vide order dated 26th May, 2021 granted the interim
bail subject to joining investigation. The order is reproduced below:-

*“ The petitioner herein seeks the concession of
anticipatory bail in the criminal case as registered at Police
Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala vide FIR No.10 dated
18.03.2021 under Sections 420/120-B IPC and Sections 7 and
7A of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.*

Notice of motion.

*Ms. Rashmi Attri, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab,
who has joined the proceedings on behalf of the respondent in
this case, in pursuance of the copy of this petition having been*

sent to the respondent-State in advance, accepts the notice. However, she seeks time to file a detailed written reply in the present matter.

Let the same be filed on or before 05.07.2021 with the copy thereof to the counsel opposite, well in advance.

Meanwhile, in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

The petitioner shall join in the investigation as and when required to do so and shall also abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajneesh Kaushal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the interim bail granted on 26th May, 2021 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
