This petition has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of a direction to the respondents to take necessary steps to treat the persons with disability on priority basis during Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned Additional Solicitor General appearing for Union of India, learned Senior Standing Counsel appearing for Union Territory, Chandigarh, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab and learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana submit that they all have already taken such necessary steps in this regard. They further submit that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent-authorities by filing a detailed representation, if any, regarding deficiencies in providing medical aid to the disabled persons, the same shall be considered and a decision thereon would be taken in accordance with law.
