In view of above, instant application is dismissed as withdrawn.

Main case

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail has been moved by petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 05.05.2021 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that compromise-cum-settlement deed dated 09.06.2021 (Annexure P-26), already arrived at between petitioner and complainant, terms and conditions thereof are being fulfilled.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Satvinder Kumar Chopra, submits that in compliance of order dated 08.07.2021, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 08.07.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
