The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.46 dated 09.04.2021, lodged under Sections 323, 325, 354, 506, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 27.05.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. He has further stated that it is a case of version and cross version wherein both the parties had received injuries at the hands of each other. This fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer and submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners by urging that the petitioners had indulged in inappropriate behaviour as the clothes of the complainant were torn-off by the petitioners during the occurrence.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Daljit Kumar, states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 27.05.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
