This petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking a direction to the respondents to notify the requisite standards for operating the CNG (Compressed Natural Gas)/PNG (Piped Natural Gas) fired brick kilns and to provide the requisite infrastructure in order to continue with the operation of brick kilns in accordance with the order dated 17.02.2021 (Annexure P-18) passed by the National Green Tribunal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they have already filed the representations dated 22.04.2021 and 23.04.2021 (Annexures P-19 and P-20) before the respondent-authorities which are pending consideration.

Mr. Ankur Mittal, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appearing for respondents No. 1, 2, 3 and 5 as well as Mr. Satya Pal Jain, learned Additional Solicitor General of India, appearing for respondent No. 4, submit that the respondent-authorities shall consider and pass a detailed order on the representations filed by the petitioners and communicate the same to the petitioners as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel as well as learned Additional Solicitor General of India, we do not find any reason to entertain the present petition which is disposed of. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and, therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
