At the outset, Mr. P.K.S. Phoolka, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the reply filed by the State, in which it has been stated that there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition. He has further submitted that in case in future there is any threat, he may be granted liberty to approach this Court again.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to say that petitioners are always at liberty to approach the appropriate Court for the protection of life and liberty in accordance with law whenever they apprehend any real danger at the hands of the private respondents.
