LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.08, dated 07.02.2021 under Sections 307, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Valtaha, District Taran Tarn.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Magistrate within one week. However, it is prayed that the application for bail, which shall be filed alongwith, be decided in a time bound manner.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that in case, petitioner surrenders before the Magistrate concerned within one week from today, his application for regular bail, if any, be decided within two weeks thereafter in accordance with law.

It is clarified that there is no expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
