The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 23 dated 09.07.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on instructions of this Court dated 08.08.2018, he has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation yet recovery of 15 *tolas* of gold apart from 25 *tolas* of silver jewellery is yet to be made.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated qua the petitioner and the petitioner has joined the investigation and a perusal

of the previous orders would show that the mediation *inter se* the parties have failed. As far as the recovery of gold and silver jewellery is concerned, it would be a matter of trial as whether or not the receipts issued pertaining to the jewellery are genuine document. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.08.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
