The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.56, dated 23.08.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner along with co-accused was apprehended with 210 grams Tramadol.

Keeping in view the fact that the quantity allegedly recovered falls within the ambit of non-commercial quantity, the learned trial court granted bail vide order dated 09.05.2019, however, the petitioner is alleged to have jumped the bail.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this bench is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. However, if the petitioner applies for bail after surrendering before the trial court within one week from today, the same shall be decided by the court within 3 days thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
