The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.8 dated 18.02.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, , 427, 379, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 326, 325, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Ghuman, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

For the same relief as sought in the present petition the petitioner had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-16977-2021 – Gurpreet Singh vs. State of Punjab which petition of his was dismissed on merits on 23.04.2021. The petitioner has filed the instant petition by concealing the factum of filing and dismissal of his earlier petition. Rather, he has sworn a false affidavit that the present petition is the first petition filed by him before this Court for the grant of anticipatory bail.

On merits the petitioner's case for the grant of anticipatory bail had already been rejected by this Court on 23.04.2021. No subsequent

event warranting interference has neither been pleaded nor argued. Further, in the present petition the petitioner has concealed the factum of filing and dismissal of his earlier petition. He has rather sworn a false affidavit that prior to the filing of the present petition he has not filed before this Court any similar petition.

In view of the above no merit is found in the present petition.
