Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he, along with his family members, apprehends danger to their life at the hands of the accused persons named by him in his complaint dated 07.05.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a fraud has been committed by the accused persons with the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner has made a representation/complaint dated 07.05.2021 to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 for registering a criminal case under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B, against the accused persons, but no action has been taken till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he would be satisfied, if representation dated 07.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) filed

by the petitioner, is decided by respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3-State, at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

In view of the aforesaid prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, to decide the representation dated 07.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner within one month, in accordance with law, after receipt of the copy of this order.
