The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.05, dated 07.01.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Bhushan Lal who has stated that Aniket @ Honey quarrelled with him 4-5 months ago. On 06.01.2021, Aniket alongwith his accomplices including the petitioner caused injury to the first informant.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not attributed any overt act, he is only shown to be having a

police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been filed.

Mr. Ankur Mittal, Addl. AG, Haryana, admits that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
