After arguing for some time, in view of the fact that FIR was registered way back on 04.02.2019 and the trial against other accused is proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner may be permitted to surrender before the trial Court and apply for grant of regular bail as the victims Irshad and Asgar have sworn affidavit that the petitioner was not involved in the incident.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that trial Court may be directed to decide the regular bail application of the petitioner on the same day considering the aforesaid fact.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on 07.06.2021 at 10.00 AM and on doing so, the trial Court shall decide the regular bail application of the petitioner on the same day by taking into consideration the aforesaid affidavit filed by the victims.
