Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the petitioner got registered FIR No.114 dated 13.07.2016 under Sections 120-B, 148, 323 and 354(A) IPC read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar, against private respondents No.4 to 11, but till date no progress has been made in that FIR. He further submits that petitioner has already made representation dated 26.04.2021 to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, copy of which is available on record as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, to look into and decide representation dated 26.04.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
