Petitioner-Raj Bala, stated to be aged 54 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned orders dated 05.03.2021 and 19.03.2021 (Annexures P-7 & P-8 respectively).

On 27.05.2021, this Court had issued notice of motion.

In response thereto, written statement of Shri Rajiv Deswal, IPS, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Headquarters, Gurugram, has been

filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 7. Along with the written statement, an order dated 18.06.2021 has been appended as Annexure R-I, whereby, a punishment of stoppage of one increment with temporary effect, has been imposed.

In this view of the matter, the present writ petition, as submitted by learned State counsel, has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, if so advised, may move an application for revival, after obtaining instructions from the petitioner, if anything survives in the petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
