**RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):**

Pursuant to the previous orders passed by this Court, learned counsel appearing for the parties submit that they have entered into an amicable settlement pursuant to which the necessary amount due from the petitioner has been deposited with the Amity University which in turn has already issued the original migration certificate and the character certificate. It is also informed by learned counsel appearing for the Amity University that the original migration certificate and character certificate have already been sent through speed post to the candidate. In these circumstances, nothing further survives for adjudication in the writ petition.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent-Panjab University be directed to take the necessary steps of declaration of result etc. on receiving the original migration certificate and character certificate.

Learned counsel appearing for the Panjab University submits that the Panjab University shall take the necessary steps of declaring the result and regularizing the petitioner's admission within a week on receiving the original migration certificate and character certificate.

Recording the aforesaid statement(s) of learned counsel for the parties, the petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of.
