By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to respondents no.2 to 6 to take proper action on the basis of the complaint/legal representation dated 14.03.2021 (copy Annexure P-5) made to them, on the basis of the petitioners' earlier representation dated 08.03.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Addl. Director General of Police, NRI (Punjab), Mohali, to go into his grievance and to take a decision on the action to be taken, within a specified time frame.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Addl. Director General of Police (NRI), Punjab (respondent no.3), to go into the grievance of the petitioner and to take action as is warranted as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

(The contention of the petitioner is that his property in India has

been fraudulently sold to one Jarnail Singh on 26.08.2020. Learned counsel submits that though the petitioner is in Canada, a close relative (and power of attorney) Satwant Singh, would pursue the case on his behalf.)
