The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C with a prayer that the respondents be directed to take appropriate immediate action in respect of FIR No.61 dated 25.04.2021 registered under Sections 363, 366, and 34 of IPC at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar and the petitioner be informed about the outcome of the said investigations. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the daughter of the petitioner has been abducted by respondent No.4 and though, FIR No.61 dated 25.04.2021 has been registered but, no effective steps have been taken by the police to investigate the allegations alleged in the said FIR so as to recover the daughter of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions from respondent No.3 to inform this Court that all required actions in investigation of FIR No.61 dated 25.4.2021 are being undertaken and needful will be done at the earliest so as to find the whereabouts of the missing daughter of the petitioner in respect of FIR No.61 dated 25.4.2021 by escalating the efforts to complete the investigation at the earliest. Learned State counsel further submits that the required action will be taken by the police authorities within a period of two weeks from today and the outcome of the investigation will also be brought to the notice of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel recorded hereinbefore, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, at this stage, and he does not press the present petition any further, at this stage and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that the respondents will be bound by their statement recorded above and it will be appreciated by this Court if efforts are made to locate the daughter of the petitioner at the earliest.
